



Maine Quarter Horse Association Year End Award Rules

To be eligible for show year-end awards of the Maine Quarter Horse Association:

1. The owner (lessee) of the horse must be a member of MeQHA in good standing no later than the last day of the show.
2. The exhibitor of the horse must be a member of MeQHA in good standing.
3. In the class to earn points, the horse must be shown, judged and place in the top 9 to all 4 judges at the Pine Tree Classic.
4. The intent to show form and fee must be filed with the association by the owner (lessee) no later the end of the Pine Tree Classic Show. There must be an intent to show form and fee filed for each horse.
5. Points are awarded in a class based on the 9 point scoring system. First place receives the amount of points of the number of exhibitors in the class, up to 9. Points will reduce by 1 for each placing after first. Example: If there are 9 in a class, 1st gets 9pts, 2nd gets 8pts, 3rd gets 7pts, etc. If there are 4 in the class, 1st gets 4pts, 2nd gets 3pts, etc.
6. The winner of the year-end award is responsible to attain the award(s) at the annual banquet. If the winner is not attending, MeQHA assumes no responsibility for the award(s) following the annual awards banquet. Winner may contact awards chairperson prior to the banquet and make arrangements by paying to have the awards shipped to them, or have someone else assume responsibility by picking them up.
